Functional Leadership for Property

Portfolio: State Services

On 3 December 2013, the Cabinet Committee on State Sector Reform and Expenditure Control (SEC):

- noted that the functional leadership for property is proposing a direction under section 107 of the Crown Entities Act 2004 to apply to all Crown agents (except District Health Boards) to:
 - 1.1 ensure consistent, efficient and reliable on going implementation;
 - 1.2 manage the risks associated with the current level of cooperation decreasing;
- noted the proposed text of the direction for consultation as set out in the submission under SEC (13) 63;
- invited the Ministers of State Services and Finance to report to SEC on the outcome of the consultation by 31 March 2014.
