Our response

As mentioned in our response to your official information request (OIA 2024-0063) dated 12 March 2024, both the Medical Council of New Zealand and the Dental Council of New Zealand are not part of the Public Service. The Nursing Council of New Zealand is also not part of the Public Service.

Therefore, all three Council entities do not fall under any of the 15 Public Service sectors listed on Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission's website.
