I refer to your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request received by the Public Service Commission (the Commission) on 4 May 2026 for:

"I request the spreadsheet covering a list of all current board members for government boards or organisations, including the title or role they were appointed to, their organisation that they were appointed to, and the date of their appointment."

Information being released

In order to respond to your request, the Commission has collated information provided by agencies through AppointNet, which is a centralised, all-of-government digital system used to record, manage, and report on appointments to public sector boards and committees.

AppointNet is developed and administered by the Commission, however monitoring agencies of boards input and maintain their own appointment data. As such, please note the following caveats regarding the information being released to you:

- The Commission has endeavoured to provide you with the most 'current' information possible, which has included updates provided by agencies following the date of your request.
- AppointNet is currently being rolled out so the information contained is not a complete record. For example, some members may not be included in the spreadsheet where they have been recently appointed, the monitoring agency has not yet added their information to AppointNet, and/or members have not yet provided their permission for their data to be included in AppointNet.
- Some internal advisory groups and dedicated programme boards have been removed as out of scope.

For a more accurate record, you may wish to contact the monitoring agencies of government boards and/or organisations that you are interested in and request information from them directly, or search via the New Zealand Gazette website.
