- *The ChatGPT transcripts (between May 12th until May 19th) of all Public Service Commission staff members who contributed to advice (related to artificial intelligence) provided to the Minister between May 12th until May 19th. This includes the prompts provided by the staff members, and the responses provided by ChatGPT.*

Information does not exist

The Public Service Commission (Commission) did not provide any advice related to Artificial Intelligence to the Minister for the Public Service during the period of 12-19 May 202. As no advice was sent to the Minister, there are no prompts from Commission staff members relevant to your request. As previously stated in our OIA response [OIA 2026-0140] the Commission does not utilise ChatGPT.

Therefore, we are refusing your request in full under section 18(e) of the Official Information Act 1982 on the grounds the information requested does not exist.
