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### **Official Information Request**

**Our Ref: OIA 2026-0174**

I refer to your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request transferred from the Department of Internal Affairs (DIA) to the Public Service Commission Te Kawa Mataaho (the Commission) on 8 June 2026 for:

*“Could you please supply me with following information*

- 1. The address/suburb and town of all the data centres been built so far in New Zealand*
- 2. The address/suburb and town of the planned data centres to be built or under construction now”.*

### **Our Response**

On 1 April 2026, the functions of the Government Chief Digital Office (GCDO) transferred from DIA and were established as the Government Digital Delivery Agency (GDDA) within the Commission. As part of these functions, the GDDA carries out Infrastructure as a Service (IaaS) and Public Cloud Data Centre (PCDC) certifications.

### **Information being released**

The GDDA does not hold a list of all Data Centres in New Zealand. Listed in the table below are the locations of the Data Centres certified by the GDDA under the traditional IaaS Certification framework. Please note there is currently no legal requirement to register a facility, but GDDA provides optional certification for those wishing to be part of the All of Government (AoG) PCDC certification.
