Please provide records relating to Police attendance, contact, or action connected with 9(2)(a) privacy on 25 June 2026, including any attendance at 9(2)(a) privacy 9(2)(a), 9(2)(a) privacy home address at 9(2)(a) privacy, or another associated location.

To the extent held and able to be released, please provide:

- the event report, occurrence report, and final event disposition for Police event 9(2)(a)
- CAD, dispatch, communications, and call-for-service records, including the initial call, dispatch, attendance, and closure;
- attendance notes and observations recorded by Officer 9(2)(a) privacy or any other attending officer, directly relevant to 9(2)(a) privacy presentation, apparent impairment, behaviour, ability to communicate, memory or recall, driving, or immediate risk to himself or others;
- statements taken from 9(2)(a) privacy, 9(2)(a) employees, family members, or other witnesses in relation to the event;
- records directly relating to any medication, drugs, alcohol, dangerous items, vehicles, or property dealt with by Police;
- any welfare assessment, mental-health crisis response, ambulance involvement, hospital transfer, referral, or safety action taken by Police; and
- any record of Police enquiries about whether 9(2)(a) privacy presented a risk of aggression, violence, self-harm, or harm to others, together with the response recorded.

Please search for any Police call-for-service, welfare check, mental-health crisis attendance, transport assistance, safety assessment, or occurrence involving 9(2)(a) privacy at 9(2)(a) privacy, elsewhere in Cromwell or in Clyde between 29 January 2025 and 2 February 2025.

- the date, time, and location of any attendance;
- CAD or communications records;
- attendance notes and actions taken;
- any immediate safety assessment recorded; and
- the final disposition.
