I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 13 May 2025 for:

"I hope you are doing well. My name is 9(2)(a) privacy and I live at 9(2)(a) privacy, 9(2)(a) privacy . I would like the details of the offender or the offenders brother. The police said that the person riding it said their brother gave them my stolen bike. I need the police report and also camera footage from the area so I can show the police. My moped was stolen and then recovered with someone riding on the back of it. Somehow the police thought that there was not enough evidence to investigate this further, but I believe there is. I have spoken to a lawyer and they have told me to request the offenders information from you. Can you please help me? the moped was stolen from oriental parade on 9(2)(a) and I believe there should be camera footage of the bike being stolen. This was the police file number 9(2)(a) They said the offender was a youth so there was nothing they could do. I am also a youth so I find this quite unjust as it is unfair to me to have to pay for all these expenses when I didn't even cause the damage to the vehicle. Sorry if this is confusing but please feel free to email back".

In these circumstances, we are required by section 14 of the Official Information Act 1982 to transfer your request.
