With Cabinet agreement the new agency will be established by 1 July On 2 May we provided you with a draft LEG paper for ministerial consultation [2024-0131 refers] and undertook targeted agency consultation with the Treasury and Social Wellbeing Agency. There were no changes to the paper through this process.

The number of orders to give effect to the changes was able to be accommodated in two orders rather than the four noted in the original draft paper. The Parliamentary Counsel Office will provide the orders to the Cabinet Office directly. We have provided your Office with advice sheets for the Executive Council meeting on 27 May.
