Background

- We are required to provide the Open Government Partnership (OGP) with a self-assessment of the implementation of each National Action Plan. This paper seeks your agreement to release the draft self-assessment of delivery of the OGP National Action Plan 2018-21 (NAP3) for public comment in early November for a period of two weeks, before it is finalised for submission to the OGP. We are required to submit the self-assessment by the end of November 2021.
- The self-assessment describes the context in which NAP3 was delivered and summarises the End-of-Term Reports on the commitments under NAP3 that have been prepared by the lead agencies. OGP process requires that we seek public comment on the self-assessment before it is submitted. The Endof-Term Reports will be published at the same time.
- NAP3 originally consisted of 12 commitments involving 43 milestones. Seven milestones were added during the term of the plan (which was extended for a year in 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic) and two were unable to be progressed as planned after receiving additional information. The commitments have now been substantially completed. Forty four of 50 milestones will be completed during the term of the plan and work will continue in these areas beyond the end of the NAP3.
- At the same time as this self-assessment is being finalised, the OGP Independent Review Mechanism reviewer (Keitha Booth) is undertaking an independent review of the implementation of NAP3. We will have an opportunity to comment on this review before it is published.
