





Order

1 Title

This order is the Crown Entities (Consultation on Collective Employment Agreements) Order 2025.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 16 June 2025.

3 Interpretation


In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, **specified parties** means the following statutory entities and their respective employees, or classes of employees, who are subject to a collective employment agreement:

- (a) Health New Zealand; and
- (b) Fire and Emergency New Zealand.

4 Consultation on collective employment agreements

The specified parties must not agree to terms and conditions of employment in a collective employment agreement, or to an amendment to those terms and conditions, without—

- (a) consulting the Public Service Commissioner; and
- (b) having regard to the recommendations that the Commissioner makes to the relevant statutory entity within a reasonable time of being consulted.
